Who Should Attend? Attorneys, CPAs, Enrolled Agents and other Tax Practitioners.  
**Note:** Enrolled Agents are entitled to 1 CPE Credit; other tax professionals may qualify depending on the requirements of their organizations.

Why Attend? Hear from Campus Subject Matter Experts who will provide you with an overview of Campus Compliance Services and the Automated Underreporter (AUR) program.

The purpose of AUR program is to reconcile information returns filed on forms W-2, 1098, 1099, etc., with income and deductions reported on prior year income tax returns. If AUR is unable to match the information with the filed return, we may issue notice CP2000, We Are Proposing Changes to Your Tax Return. This notice informs the recipient that we're proposing changes to their tax return based on different information reported to us by their employers, banks, and other payers.

The presentation will be followed by a Question and Answer period. This is your opportunity to have your questions answered, however, due to the public nature of this call; we will not be able to help you with specific client issues.
